CONFERENCE CALLED MEETING

May 21, 2019

In attendance for the Board: Ronda Jones, Dr, Kandaria, Ashley McCollough, Susan Magas

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and read the Ethics and Conflict of Interest reminder. All board members in attendance stated they had no conflicts.

The topic for discussion was consideration of the EANC seminar. A total of 43 documents including topic summaries and speakers' resumes' were previously distributed to board members in preparation for this meeting. On a motion from Kandaria, seconded by McCullough, the seminar was approved.

As Dennis Seavers, Executive Director for the Barber Board, was in attendance, Chairman Jones asked him to update participants on the status of proposed merger between NCBE and the Barber Board. He provided the following information:

- . H444 is a bill that involves issues the Barber Board seeks to enact for its agency, primarily fee increases for various licenses.
- . The merger language was formerly included in H590, but was removed from that bill.
- . Rep. Stevens, Speaker Pro Tem, is deciding whether or not to reinsert the merger language in H444.
- . H444 is not subject to the crossover deadline that impacts much legislation which has time limits on both bodies to pass companion bills.

As there was no other business, Jones adjourned the meeting at 7:06 p.m.
