PART A: Failure in this section will demand a 15-day correction period

1. Use of an autoclave or dry heat sterilizer					
2. Accumulated Forceps after use are held in a covered holding container by submersion in a solution of a protein-dissolving enzyme detergent and water.					
3. Biological indicators used on monthly basis <u>and</u> filed permanently in a Quality Assurance File kept on premises					
4. Use of non-sterile examination gloves					
5. Single-use, pre-sterilized disposable probes					
6. All containers used for dispensing to include Sharps container shall all be clearly labeled					
PART B: Failure in this section will demand a 30-day correction period					
INSPECTION ELEMENT:				PASS	FAIL
1. Face mask clean lab coat or scrubs worn during each treatment					
2. Pre-sterilized instruments and other items stored in a test tube or packaged					
3. Instruments cleaned prior to sterilization either ultrasonically or by hand with a germicide effective against HIV, staphylococcus, herpes, and HPV					
4. Use of treatment table or chair specifically designed for client treatment					
5. Sinks and toilet facilities clean and ample supply					
6. Covered plastic lined trash receptacle in each treatment room					
PART C: Failure in this section will demand a 60-day correction period					
INSPECTION ELEMENT:				PASS	FAIL
1. Health History Assessment according to 21NCAC 19.0409					
2. Low-level hospital grade disinfectant used for cleaning non-critical surfaces i.e., epilator, lamps, etc.					
3. Treatment table shall be covered with fresh disposable paper, drape or barrier					
4. Adequate supply of gloves, cotton balls, antiseptic products, and cleaning materials					
5. Original license and current renewal certificate displayed in a conspicuous place
